

### TailGunner Duties:

- The TailGunner is the last to leave the campground each morning. Makes sure that everyone departs the campground safely.
- TailGunner prepares and makes available to guests, morning coffee.
- Makes sure all guests make it safely to the next stop by traveling behind the guests. All of our RVs are marked with a distinctively colored patch.
- Assist any of our guests that may break-down along the way by doing minor mechanical troubleshooting and repair. Example: Guest has a flat tire. TailGunner would assist in changing tire. For repairs that are beyond the capabilities of the TailGunner, assist the guest in getting repairs by securing help in the next town. Stay with the guest until repairs are complete and guest is able to travel again. Keep TourMaster informed of all break-downs.
- Assist any of our guests in a medical emergency by getting help from the first available source. Stay with guest until emergency help arrives. Keep TourMaster informed of all medical emergencies.
- Assist TourMaster by helping to prepare, serve and clean-up less than 10 meals during the tour.
- Take direction from the TourMaster.
- Be helpful, friendly and courteous to guests at all times.

### TailGunner Requirements:

- Must have a motorhome or RV and tow vehicle capable of traveling the Alaska tour route safely and reliably.
- Must have good social skills able to be helpful and courteous to our guests and the TourMaster.
- Non-drinker.
- Illegal drugs will not be tolerated.
- Non-smoker preferred.
- Must be in good health with no restrictions that will prevent the performance of the TailGunner Duties.
- Well behaved and controlled pets are welcome.
- Must be able to commit to the entire tour.
